

All activities at Leading Creek Watershed Camp are designed to engage students in learning while having fun!



#### **DETAILS of DAY CAMP**

Watershed Summer Camp will be held on Wednesday June 11th & Thursday June 12th. Camp runs from

9:00a.m. to 4:00p.m. Parents/Guardians should note that the drop-off time is at 9:00 and pick-up time is 4:00. Camp is held at the Meigs SWCD **Conservation Area along New Lima Road near Rutland, Ohio.** 

Lessons at Watershed Camp will be prepared for students entering  $5^{th}$ ,  $6^{th}$ ,  $7^{th}$ , and  $8^{th}$  grades (ages 9 to 14 years old).

Watershed Camp is free! There is **NO FEE** for campers to attend. Lunch and one snack per day will also be provided for each camper. Sunscreen and bug spray should be applied *before* the camper arrives at camp.



#### Instructors

Instructors at the camp are staff members of the Meigs SWCD, Hocking Hills State Park, Ohio Department of Natural Resources, OSU Extension, and many other agencies.
