Meigs Soil and Water Conservation District — 2024 Tree and Wildlife Packet Sale

Coniferous Trees (packets of 25)

Bald Cypress (Taxodium distichum) Large, slow-growing, deciduous conifer. Frequently reaches 100-120 ft. in height and 3-6 ft. in diameter.

Eastern Redcedar (Juniperus virginiana) Medium growing, excellent windbreak. Mature 30 ft. 15ft spread. Any soil type, full to partial sun. Do not plant near apple trees.

Eastern White Pine (Pinus strobus) An outstanding timber pine due to its large size (80+ ft. at maturity) and fast growing ability.

Norway Spruce (Picea abies) Faster-growing spruce. Reaches 100 ft at maturity. Grows well on most sites. Ornamental.

Virginia Pine (Pinus virginia) Small-to-medium tree reaches up to 70 ft. Does best in full sun in well-drained soils. Slow growing; resistant to deer.

Deciduous Trees (packets of 25)

Black Cherry (Prunus serotina) Commercially important tree growing to 60+ ft. at maturity. Tolerates a wide variety of growing conditions.

Black Walnut (Juglans nigra) Mature height and spread is 70 ft. Prefers full to part sun.

Northern Red Oak (Quercus rubra) Tall, relatively fast growing tree that can reach 80+ ft. at maturity. Prefers full sun and acidic soil.

Sugar Maple (Acer saccharum) This large shade tree, which can reach heights over 100 ft. Prefers partial to full sun and well-drained soil.

White Oak (Quercus alba) A large, broadleaf tree growing to 100+ ft. at maturity. This species grows best in deep, sandy loam soil.

Wildlife Packet (4 each of the following species - 24 seedlings total - No Substitutions)

Chinkapin Oak (Quercus muehlenbergii) Medium growing. 40-60ft mature height. 50-70ft spread. Full sun and wide range of soils. Relatively pest free.

American Elderberry (Sambucus canadensis) Native deciduous shrub reaches mature height up 12 feet in medium to wet well-drained soils. Full sun to part shade.

American Plum (Prunus americana) White, pungent sweet blossoms in early spring. Mature height of 20 feet with spread of 25 feet in wide range of conditions.

Hazelnut (Corylus americana) Nut-producing shrub prefers full sun to partial shade. Plant together to ensure cross pollination. Edible nuts are attractive to wildlife.

Persimmon (Diospyros virginiana) Slow to medium growing up to 50 feet. Full to partial sun in all but wet spots. Persimmons are often pureed or baked into goods.

Shagbark Hickory (Carya laciniosa) Slow growing, large deciduous tree that can reach 60-80 feet high. Prefers rich, medium to wet soils. Excellent for wildlife.

Hardwood Packet (4 each of the following species—20 seedlings total—no substitutions)

Black Cherry (Prunus serotina) See above

Black Walnut (Juglans nigra) See above

White Oak (Quercus alba) See above

Tulip (Yellow) Poplar (Liriodendron tulipifera) Fast-growing. Mature heights 80ft with a spread of 40ft. Full sun and prefers moist soil but well drained. Flowers late May.

Fruits and Mushrooms

<u>Dwarf Grimes Golden Apple</u> (2 trees) Height and spread of about 10ft. Well drained soil, full sun. Great all around apple. Fruit around September. Self pollinating.

Shiitake Mushroom (1 kit) Kit contains 200 inoculated shiitake dowel plugs, 1/4lb. bees wax, wax dauber, 5 metal tags for labeling and an easy to follow growers guide.

Seed Mixes

Whitetail 365 Food Plot Mix (25 lb. bag) A "throw and go" mix. An excellent choice for the landowner who wants to attract wildlife. Covers ½ acre.

Erosion Control Seed Mix (2 lb. bag) For severe erosion control measures. Covers 2000 sq. ft.

Showy Northeast Native Wildflower & Grass Seed Mix (1 oz. packet) Excellent for native meadows. Covers 200 sq. ft.

Ohio Pollinator Seed Mix High-quality long-lasting wildlife habitat, meets or exceeds conservation agency standards. Details available at meigsswcd.com

Ohio Pollinator (NO GRASSES) Seed Mix Meets or exceeds conservation agency standards. Species details available at meigsswcd.com

Native Groundcover

Wild Ginger (Asarum candensis) Spreads slowly by rhizomes. Height is 4-8 inches at maturity. Plant 8-12 inches apart. 25 bulbs per packet.

Partridge Berry (Mitchella reptans) Height is 2 inches at maturity. Plant 8-12 inches apart. 25 bulbs per packet. Tolerates heavy shade and dry conditions.

Wild Geranium (Geranium maculatum) Semi-evergreen. 1-2ft in height. Plant 8-12 inches apart. 25 starts per packet. Prefers part to full shade. Attracts many pollinators.
