Leading Creek Watershed



Where?

The Leading Creek Watershed consists of approximately 150 square miles. It stretches across the western half of Meigs County and portions of Athens and Gallia counties.



Nearly 7,500 people live within the watershed.

The watershed is affected by water quality and habitat impairments caused by abandoned mine land, acid mine drainage, agriculture and logging. These impairments degrade the natural environment, which leads to a reduced quality of life for local residents and wildlife.

Projects.

The LCCC will build on the accomplishments of the Meigs SWCD.

Some of these accomplishments include:

- Environmental Covenants
- Stream Sweeps
- Conservation Area (174 acres)
- Farm Bill Programs (NRCS)
- Educational Programs & Workshops

NEW Projects.

The committee needs you to design new, lasting projects to ensure stewardship of the watershed. Examples include:
